hundreds of songs can be played knowing just these!

That should be inspiration enough to get started.

Learn these 48 chords. Don't even be concerned with major 7ths, dominant 7ths, minor 7ths, etc., right now... after all, once you can play these triads, it's just a matter of adding one note to each of them to play any 7th chord you want to. So master the 48 triads first.

Considering the importance of knowing these chords to establish a good foundation, combined with the fact that I feel anyone and everyone can learn them... and my conviction that the process should be nothing less than a lot of fun, I decided to create a sure-fire system which no one can fail at!
